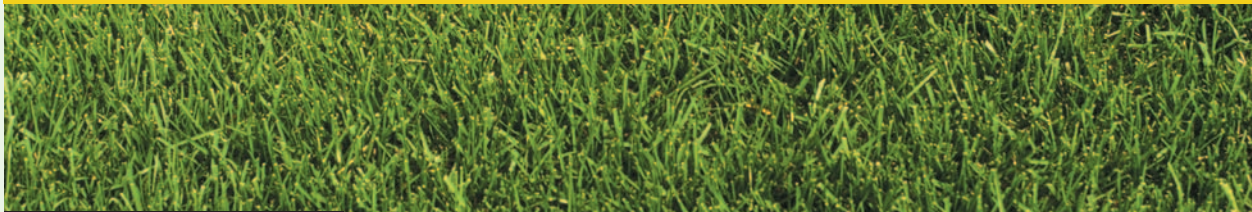

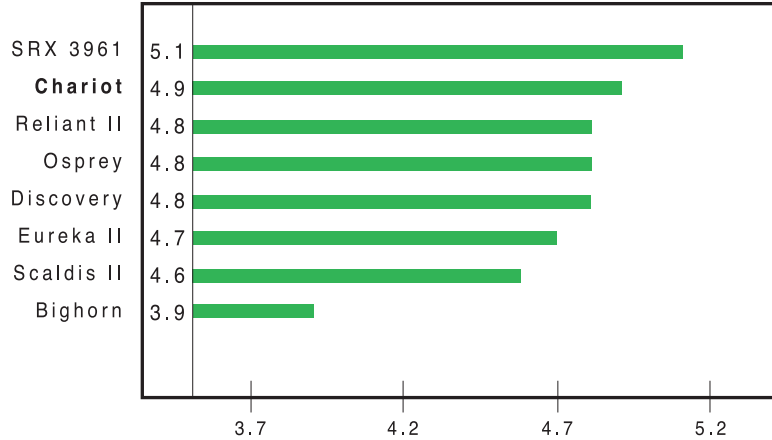
### **HEAT AND DROUGHT STRESS STANDOUT**

Chariot is an advanced generation synthetic bred for appearance and persistence under environmental extremes in both shade and sun.

Chariot establishes quickly forming a darker dense stand in most soil types. It stands up to traffic and retains its density through heat and drought stresses well into fall. Chariot has a broad disease resistance profile, particularly to blight, red thread and pythium.

Chariot's toughness makes it an excellent choice for residential turf as well as roadsides, parks, and ski slopes. Left unmown, its wavy appearance forms an attractive and colorful links look suitable for golf course roughs and steeper slopes for erosion control.

**OVERALL QUALITY — NO IRRIGATION**



**CHARIOT** forms an attractive persistent turf under most soils and level of maintenance, even when irrigation is minimal or lacking.

**CHARIOT** exhibits excellent overall disease and insect resistance, particularly during late summer into fall.

NTEP 02-04, 1-9, 9 = no disease.

**CHARIOT** is very winter hardy judged by its excellent percentage of ground cover and early greenup in spring.

NTEP 02-04. Selected varieties including highest and lowest.

**SEEDING** Broadcast seed at 4-5 lbs per 1000 sq./ft. for most applications. Erosion control and reclamation areas and ski slopes should be seeded at 150-200 lbs. per acre depending on the turf density desired. Seed golf course roughs at 200 lbs. per acre.

**MAINTENANCE** Chariot quickly establishes over a broad range of growing and environmental conditions in most soils, particularly when initial irrigation is available. On sensitive areas and slopes, levels of maintenance can be minimal with no fertilization and one mowing per season. In other turf areas, whether used alone or in combination with other grasses, maintain the stand at 2 1/2 to 3" in height. A starter type fertilizer, applied at time of seeding, will greatly enhance establishment and "fill-in".
