**SEEDING** For most applications, Zinger should be sown at 2-4 lbs per 1000 sq. ft. or 100-175 lbs per acre. Consistent watering is very important until after the first cutting. Legend is ideal for renovating existing turf that has been damaged or thinned by disease or wear. Overseed at 1 1/2 to 2 1/2 lbs per 1000 sq. ft.

**MAINTENANCE** Zinger is versatile, growing well in both full and partial shade, and under both high and low maintenance programs. Mow as necessary, removing no more than 1/3 of the leaf. Zinger can be maintained at 1/2" height when adequate moisture and nutrients are available. At a minimum, fertilize annually with 2 to 3 lbs of nitrogen per 1000 sq. ft. in a balanced formulation. More intensive programs produce a denser, more attractive turf.
