2016 Trial Data

ESTABLISHMENT

Plant in areas of full sunlight when soil temperatures reach a consistent 65 F (18 C). Plant 2-3 lbs of seed per 1,000 sq ft (1-1.5 kg/100 sq m) in a well-prepared firm seedbed. Cover seed with no more than ¼ inch (6 mm) of soil. Maintain adequate soil moisture using frequent but light irrigation for optimum germination. Seedlings should emerge in 10-14 days. As seedlings develop, decrease frequency of irrigation but increase the amount of water applied.

MAINTENANCE

Can be maintained at mowing heights from ½-2 inches (1.3-5 cm). Applying 3-5 lbs of nitrogen per 1,000 sq ft (1.5-2.5 kg/100 sq m) per growing season is adequate. Do not remove over 1/3 of the leaf blade per mowing for healthy turf. More frequent mowing at shorter heights will result in a finer, more dense turf.
