Altogether, Journey Kentucky bluegrass stands out as an excellent all-around option.

SEEDING

For most applications, Journey should be sown at 2-4 lbs per 1000 sq. ft. or 100-175 lbs per acre. Consistent watering is very important until after the first cutting. Journey is ideal for renovating existing turf that has been damaged or thinned by disease or wear. Overseed at 1½ to 2½ lbs per 1000 sq. ft.
