SEEDING

New Seeding at a rate of 1-1.5 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. in two directions with soil temperatures above 65 degrees.

Interseeding after aerifying or verticutting, preferably several times at 4-8 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. Fill core holes to 3/16 inch, seed, then topdress.
