SEEDING

Plant in areas of full sun when soil temperatures reach a consistent 65 F (18 C) and are on the rise. Plant 2-3 lbs/1000 sq ft (1-1.5 kg/100 sq m) in a well-prepared firm seedbed. Cover seed with no more than 1/4 inch (6 mm) of soil. Maintain adequate soil moisture using frequent but light irrigation for optimum germination. Seedlings should emerge in 10-14 days.

MAINTENANCE

Professional's Choice can be maintained at mowing heights from 0.5"-2" (1.3-5 cm). Applying 3-5 lbs of nitrogen per 1000 sq ft per growing season is adequate. Do not remove over 1/3 of the leaf blade per mowing for healthy turf. More frequent mowing at shorter heights will result in a finer, more dense turf.
